2005-06 ALL-CCAA HONORS

UC SAN DIEGO'S LEORA JUSTER NAMED MOST VALUABLE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

CHICO STATE'S LYNNE ROBERTS NAMED COACH OF THE YEAR

UCSD'S MICHELLE OSIER NAMED FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- UC SAN DIEGO guard **Leora Juster** has been named the 2005-06 California Collegiate Athletic Association Women's Basketball Most Valuable Player of the Year, as selected by the league head coaches. CHICO STATE's **Lynne Roberts** received CCAA Coach of the Year honors, and UCSD forward **Michelle Osier** was named CCAA Freshman of the Year. Coaches also selected the All-CCAA First and Second Teams.

Juster, a 5'8" junior from Los Angeles, led the Tritons to a 23-4 record that included a 17-3 CCAA mark, good for 2nd place in the conference. She finished the regular season as the CCAA leader in scoring (22.0 ppg), free-throw percentage (86.6%, 161-186) and three-point field goal percentage (46.9%, 30-64), ranked 5th in field goal percentage (50.9%, 202-397) and steals average (2.59 spg), 6th in assists average (4.07 apg), and 9th in assists-to-turnovers ratio (1.02).

Juster was just as, if not more, formidable in the 20-game CCAA season, as she again topped the league in scoring (22.9 ppg) and three-point shooting (47.1%, 24-51), and ranked 3rd in free-throw proficiency (84.9%, 124-146), 4th in overall shooting (51.2%, 155-303) and assists average (4.45 apg), tied for 4th in steals per game (2.40 spg), and 9th in assist-turnover ratio (0.98).

In her fourth season at Chico State, Roberts guided the Wildcats to a 24-3 regular season record, including an 18-2 league mark that earned the 'Cats a second consecutive CCAA Championship. Chico advanced to the NCAA Division II Championship West Regional for the fourth straight season under Robert's direction. The 24-win mark ties the school record set last year when the Wildcats advanced to the regional title game. Roberts' four-year career coaching record through the current regular season is 82-30 (.732).

Osier, a 6'1" forward from Placerville, was a force inside for the Tritons. She started all 27 regular season contests and averaged 13.0 points (10th in the CCAA) on 50.2 percent shooting (149-297, 6th CCAA), 9.2 rebounds (CCAA leader), 3.1 steals (CCAA leader), 1.6 assists per game and blocked 17 shots (T12th). Like Juster, Osier's averages over the 20-game CCAA schedule increased: 13.9 ppg (9th CCAA), 9.9 rpg (1st CCAA), .496 FG% (5th CCAA), 3.45 spg (1st CCAA), 0.75 bpg (12th CCAA).
